- 4. All participants are requested to bring their laptops.
- 5. Winners will be on the basis of time of submission.
- 6. If we have 2 winners at the same time then one with less number of attempts will be the winner.
- 7. It solely depends on the participant to submit code in whichever language, they are free, but the original code given in the question may vary but the processing of the code will be given in the question.

- 5. All participants are requested to bring their own laptops.
- 6. Day 1 and **till 12:00 pm of Day 2** will be development time and after that presentation on day 2 would begin.
- 7. Feedback given by mentors will be important for the evaluation
- 8. Results will be solely dependent on the discretion of the judges.
- 9. There will be a PPT shortlisting criteria before the final event
- 10. Max length of the PPT will be 4 pages and a prototype of the PPT will be given on the website.
