Short Film

A short film is a brief cinematic work that typically ranges from a few minutes to around 15 minutes in duration. It conveys a concise narrative or explores a theme, offering a compact storytelling experience within a limited time frame. Short films are a creative medium for filmmakers to showcase their skills and tell compelling stories with brevity.

GENERAL RULES AND CONDITIONS:

- 1. Duration: 10-15 minutes.
- 2. All the location which is going to be in your short film is of your college. No outside location is allowed. If any outside location is founded in the short film, the participant will be disqualified.
- 3. You also have to record the maximum event and put it in your short film as a part of it.
- 4. Topic for your short film is College Life.
- 5. Short Film is a Group Event consisting of three members in your team including you.
- 6. Only footage and videos captured during the Astitva 2023 event can be used in the short film. No pre-shot materials or external content are allowed.
- 7. Short films will be evaluated based on creativity, storytelling, cinematography, and adherence to the rules outlined in this regulation.
- 8. Participants are expected to adhere to ethical standards during the filming process. Any content deemed inappropriate or violating ethical guidelines will result in disqualification.
- *Apart from three members, you can cast people according to your script but the certificate is issued only for those members whose name is in the registration form.
